Section 3: Lesson Fees

Lessons for SHPC are \$130 for 8 spring lessons and \$130 for 8 fall lessons. You may pay for your lessons in full along with your membership or you can choose to be billed. You will be billed for your spring lessons in January with payment due by February 1st. You will be billed for your fall lessons in July with payment due by August 1st. If, your payment is not received by February 1st and/or August 1st, SHPC will assume that you are not taking group lessons and you will not be assigned to a lesson group. - Winter Camp Volunteer (mid February 2010) – plan an activity for the kids to do a winter camp, assist with driving, assist with camp activities
- Summer Camp Volunteer (June 23 – 27, 2010) - plan an activity, help with daily events, assist with performance and/or family night event
- Ad Book for Derby Day - work with chair to coordinate/organize the Derby Day Ad Book (this would be above and beyond ad sales)
- Plant Sale - work with chair to coordinate/order/distribute plants (above and beyond just selling plants)
- Logo Clothing - order and sell SHPC logo clothing; be available to sell at rallies
- Awards Dinner - organize Annual Awards Dinner
- Blue Room Coordinator - organize and inventory club equipment; update when necessary
- Librarian - maintain a list of SHPC library items for loan; monitor that items are distributed and returned
